Collecting Children from School

Please can we reinforce our procedures for collecting children from school. To ensure the safety of all children, pupils of all year groups will only be released at the end of a school day to an adult. In most cases the adult collecting children from school are the parents, but if this differs, please can you ensure that the class teachers are aware of who is collecting your son or daughter from school.

If your child is in Year 5 or Year 6 and you wish your child to walk home alone, please write into the school so that we have your permission on file to do this. In this case the teachers will release these children at the end of the school day without an adult present for them. This does mean that from Monday we will not release any child at the end of the school day to a sibling unless they are of adult age.

Many thanks for your support in this as it is for the safety of all.

Dinner Accounts

If you have debt on your child's dinner account, please can we ask that it is settled in full and that you make sure that there is money on the account for future meals. We will phone/text any parent where the child has a balance which is minus £5 or more and a packed lunch will need to be supplied. We will be unable to book a school hot meal in these situations. Lunchtime Routine

School lunch makes up one third to one half of a child's nutritional intake for an entire day and is essential for helping children succeed in school as well as grow and develop successfully and healthfully. From Monday there will be a slight change in routine for those pupils who have a packed lunch at lunchtime. All rubbish or uneaten food (except yoghurt pots/tubes or fruit skins/cores) will be put back in their lunch box to go home. The purpose of this is to enable parents to monitor what is being eaten at lunchtime. This monitoring is important because there have been occasions where a pupil has been caught throwing their lunch away but tells their parents that they have eaten it all. Thank you in advance for your co-operation with this matter and for understanding about how important this change is for the welfare of our pupils.
