Thought of the Week

This week we have continued to learn more about Moses. The story of the Exodus from the Bible is important because it shows how God rescued the Israelites from slavery in Egypt. It all starts with the last of the ten plagues, where God makes the firstborn in every Egyptian family die. But God tells the Israelites to mark their doors with lamb's blood so the plague passes over their homes, sparing them.

After this, Pharaoh finally agrees to let the Israelites go, but then changes his mind and chases after them with his army. The Israelites get trapped at the Red Sea, but God miraculously parts the waters, letting them escape safely. When Pharaoh's army tries to follow, the sea comes crashing down on them, drowning them all.

Centuries later, Jesus celebrates the Passover meal with is disciples before he gets arrested and crucified. He turns this meal into something called the Last Supper. Jesus' death and resurrection are like a new Exodus because they offer a way for people to be set free from their sins.

So, the Exodus story and the Last Supper show how God saves his people from slavery, both physically and spiritually. They remind us that God offers us a way to be free and have a life through Jesus.
